

WORKSHOP SUPPORT VOLUNTEER

Kinetika Bloco started in 2000 and our mission has been to get young people from South London engaged in long-term creative activity advancing their education, skills, and capacity. Through music, dance, design and leadership activities, we draw our influences from the Caribbean, Brazil, Africa and New Orleans. Our regular activities include workshops in Dance, Steel Pans, Samba Drumming and Brass and Woodwind.

We are looking for experienced Musicians and Dancers to volunteer with us, supporting our workshop leaders to ensure that young people are supported while learning our repertoire and prepare for performances.

What you will be doing

- Setting up group activities in advance and clearing away afterwards. This may include organising the layout of the room, preparing resources and tidying the room after the group
- Assisting young people to ensure they can keep up with the sessions and are happy and confident in what they are doing
- Role modelling positive behaviour and interactions during sessions and warm up activities
- Know where to send young people who need help e.g. First Aid
- Adhering to Kinetika Bloco's policies and procedures at all times, including Kinetika Bloco's: Safeguarding; Equality, Diversity and Inclusion; Data Protection
- Participating fully in training and supervision
